

SENATE BILLS 2010

The following bills are all growth-related, and include water, transportation, Growth Management Act and government processes, including permitting.

A “SHELL” bill is one that has no bill language yet, but intends to file one along the subject indicated. These come alive during the first half of the session. Any of these bills are potential “trains” for amendments on that bill’s subject matter. Thus, the reason we watch so many.

SB 2056 **Relating to Water Quality/Nutrients/Surface Water by Oelrich**; Directs the DEP to contract with the National Academy of Science for an evaluation of issues related to the establishment of numeric nutrient criteria. Requires the DEP and the DOACS to evaluate the sources and quantities of nutrients in surface waters

- SB 2074** **Relating to Agriculture by Peadar**; Prohibits a county from enforcing certain limits on the activity of a bona fide farm operation on agricultural land under certain circumstances. Creates the "Agricultural Land Acknowledgement Act". Requires an applicant for certain development permits to sign and submit an acknowledgement of certain contiguous agricultural lands as a condition of the political subdivision issuing the permits, etc
- SB 2080** **Relating to Water Conservation by Aronberg**; Revises the components for a comprehensive statewide water conservation program
- SB 2130** **Relating to Sovereign Immunity by Negron**

- SB 2202** **Relating to Water Supply by Haridopolos**; Creates specified provisions relating to water supply policy, planning, production, and funding. Provides for the powers and duties of water management district governing boards. Requires the DEP to develop the Florida water supply plan. Requires water management district governing boards to develop water supply plans for their respective regions. Provides for alternative water supply development, etc.
- SB 2238** **Relating to Mitigation Banks by Richter**; revises criteria for issuing permits for projects affecting wetlands; revises requirements for determining mitigation banking (HB 1175 similar)
- SB 2324** **Relating to Metropolitan Planning Organizations by Altman**; Major revisions to the MPO planning processes

- SB 2420** **Relating to State & Local Government Revenues/New Taxes/Fees by Haridopolos**; Proposes an amendment to the State Constitution to limit state and local government revenues and require voter approval of new taxes and fees
- SB 2452** **Relating to Growth Management by Bennett**; grandfathers in all applications in progress for comp plans, land development regs granted or adopted as being valid containing exemptions (in SB 360) for transportation concurrency and two year extensions of DRIs if the courts deem sections of the new law invalid; retroactive
- SB 2524** **Relating to Impact Fees by Deutch**; Authorizes counties, municipalities, and special districts to exempt certain affordable housing from payment of impact fees under certain circumstances
- SB 2600** **Relating to Local Government Comprehensive Plans by Aronberg**; Exempts certain municipalities from certain capital improvements element and schedule update requirements and certain comprehensive plan amendment prohibitions under certain circumstances. Exempts certain municipalities from certain water supply element requirements for future land use principles and guidelines

- SB 2604** **Relating to Water Management District Governing Boards by Bennett;** creates a water management district governing board nomination committee and sets for its powers; requires the legislature to approve any acquisition costs over \$50 million and any professional services over \$5 million by water management districts (HB 1407 identical)
- SB 2622** **Relating to Regulation of State Lands & Oil and Gas Resources by Haridopoulos;** Provides for the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund to accept and award bids for oil and gas leases on submerged lands underlying the territorial waters of the state. Provides for easements over sovereign submerged lands for the construction, installation, and maintenance of structures relating to the production of oil, gas, or other petroleum products, etc.
- SB 2644** **Relating to Energy Economic Zones by Bennett;** Authorizes specified tax credits and other incentives for pilot energy economic zone communities. Provides that designated energy economic zones shall be considered transportation concurrency exception areas. Provides requirements for the calculation of land required to accommodate anticipated growth for specified purposes. Exempts clean technology and manufacturing products used in energy economic zones from certain taxes, etc (HB 1461 identical)
- SB 2662** **Relating to Water Resource Protection by Altman;** Directs counties and municipalities, in cooperation with water management districts, to conduct an evaluation of primary water resources. Authorizes counties and municipalities to use funds collected for water and sewage utility usage to help finance the protection of such resources. Authorizes water management districts to expend funds received from counties and municipalities to protect water resources, etc
